3. Community Consultation Event

We still need to agree a date, time and venue for this event.

4. Work on Objectives

The current Vision Statement is:

"Our vision is to make Bromham a thriving village that builds on the welcoming and friendly nature of the Bromham community and supports our young people to stay in Bromham by having opportunities for jobs and appropriate new homes to live in. We wish to preserve and enhance the character of Bromham; with its open spaces, connecting footpaths, agricultural and horticultural heritage and diverse buildings; to promote its history and also to look to the future, so that Bromham can embrace changes that will reduce the impact of climate change and benefit the community."

We are seeking to create a set of objectives that would realise this vision.

Objectives:

We discussed the objectives previously circulated by members of the group. Some of these were more like projects or potential policies. So we attempted to separate these from things that could form headline objectives

John: Rework the list to simplify the set of objectives, by moving some items to a projects / policies column. Then circulate and pass to Place Studio for comment.

5. Progress with the Employment part of evidence gathering

Greg has spoken to some of the employers and has provided their answers to the questions regarding their employees and future plans. Jim and Tye have agreed to ask the remaining employers.

6. Initial Consideration of Local Green Space part of evidence gathering

See guidance documents provided by Place Studio.

Suggestions from Catherine:

I suggest all ancient woodlands in the Parish are green spaces. If they are already designated ancient woodland and protected, then that's fine.

It seems that Roundway and Olivers castle haves lots of protection already, AONB, natural character area, SSSI and a battlefield.

There is a triangle of green space at Chittoe common which used to be for playing cricket on. I believe it was bequeathed to the Parish, It is at the crossroads and there is a bench. The Parish Council maintain the grass (Rosalind should know ownership/status). I would suggest this is for recreation as lots of people use for flying kites, dog walking, playing games, picnic etc.

What I call Beech woods/bluebell woods at Westbrook, near the abattoir (Bryn will know). It is tranquil, beauty and wildlife (there are deer).

Millenium Cross near social centre- historic significance and beauty

Chittoe Woods- recreational, wildlife and historic for the roman road.

I would also say the Old cemetery, but that may have a designation already.

Possible areas for a long-list starting point:

- Triangle of green space at Chittoe common (by Chittoe Heath Plantation)
- Woods by abattoir
- Millenium Cross & play area
- Maples Wood (off Westbrook Road towards Sandridge)
- Wyatts Wood
- The Coppice (off Stoney Lane)
- Play area & tennis courts by Highfield

Note: The old Cemetery is already in a conservation area.

John: Put these in a document with maps to show where they are & circulate for comment.
