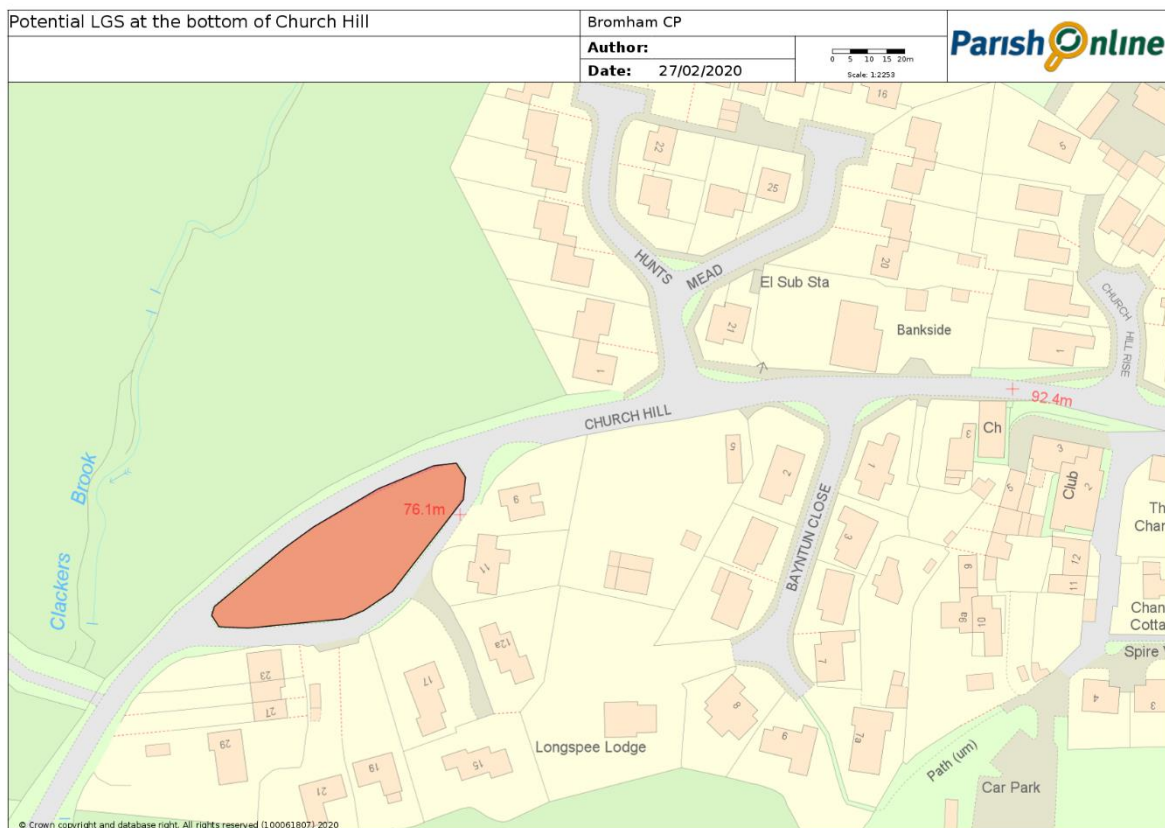
5. Progress with the Employment part of evidence gathering
